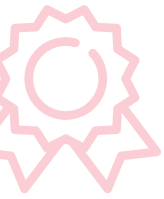

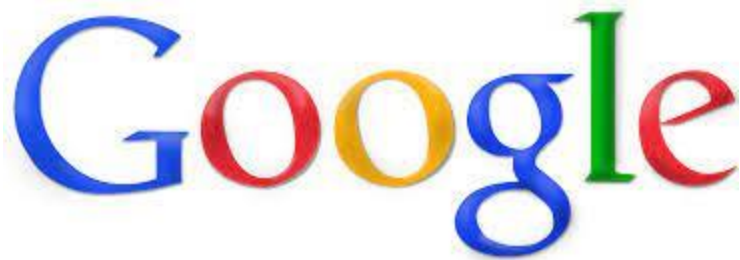

Set a Background

- Copy and paste into slide
- Insert picture from computer

2

Add a Title

- Insert text box
- Insert word art

3

Insert Clickables

- Images linked to learning sites

4

Insert Hyperlinks

- Links to learning sites

5

Insert a Ghost Box

- Clear shape over the slide
- Holds images in place
