# What is Kurzweil 3000?

- Kurzweil 3000 is a literacy technology that can read aloud (text-to-speech) virtually any text
- Enables learners to read, study, write and test to the best of their abilities.
- It is available in Standalone, Network, and Web License Edition.

# Universal Design for Learning





- A set of principles for curriculum development that gives all individuals equal opportunities to learn
- UDL provides a blueprint for creating instructional goals, methods, materials, and assessments that work for everyone--not a single, one-size-fits-all solution but rather flexible approaches that can be customized and adjusted for individual needs.

# Principles of UDL

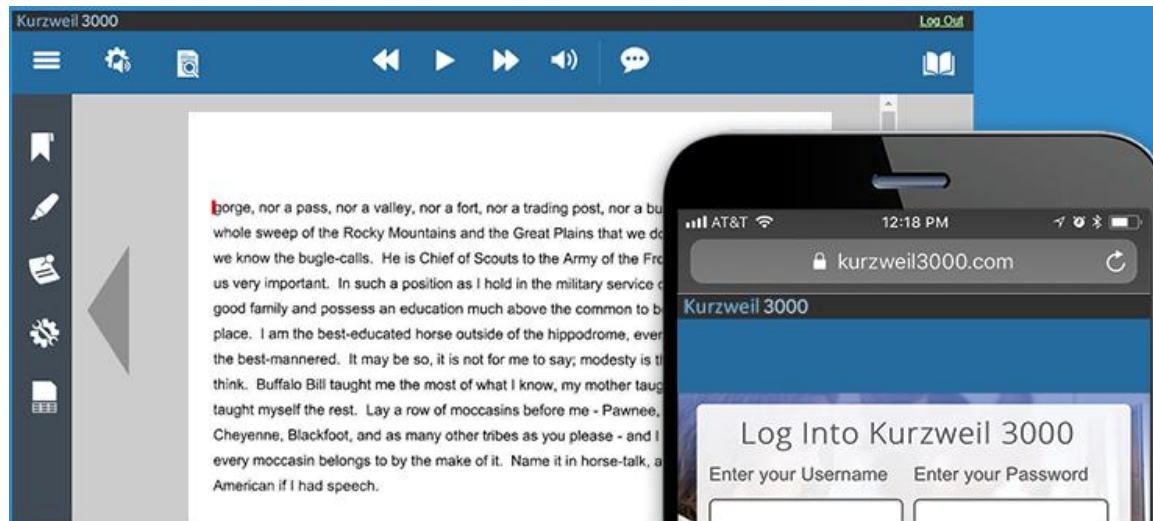
- Multiple Means of Representation (the “what” of learning)
- Multiple Means of Expression (the “how” of learning)
- Multiple Means of Engagement (the “why” of learning)

-  **Universal Library:** unlimited cloud storage accessible via Kurzweil3000.com and the installed version

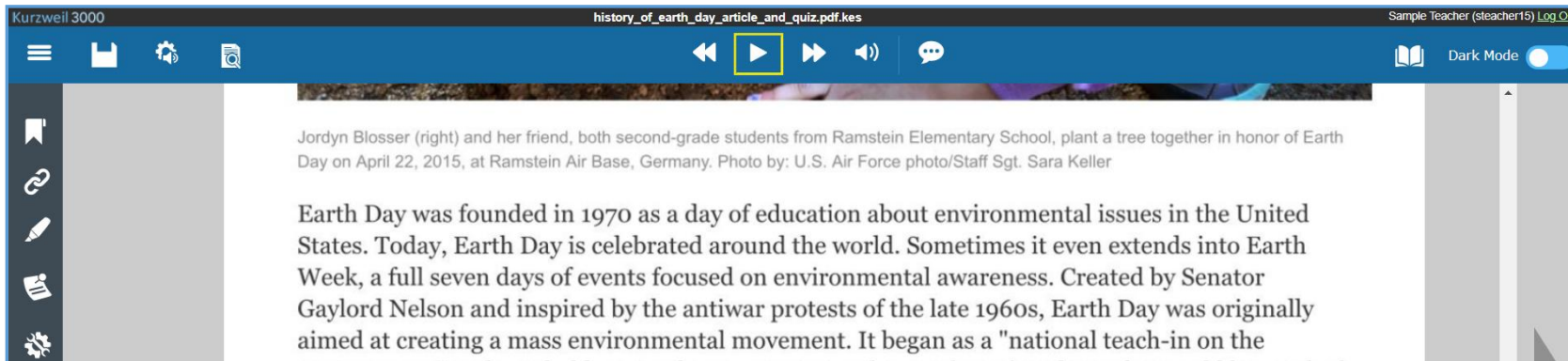

- Perfect for classroom as well as distance learning

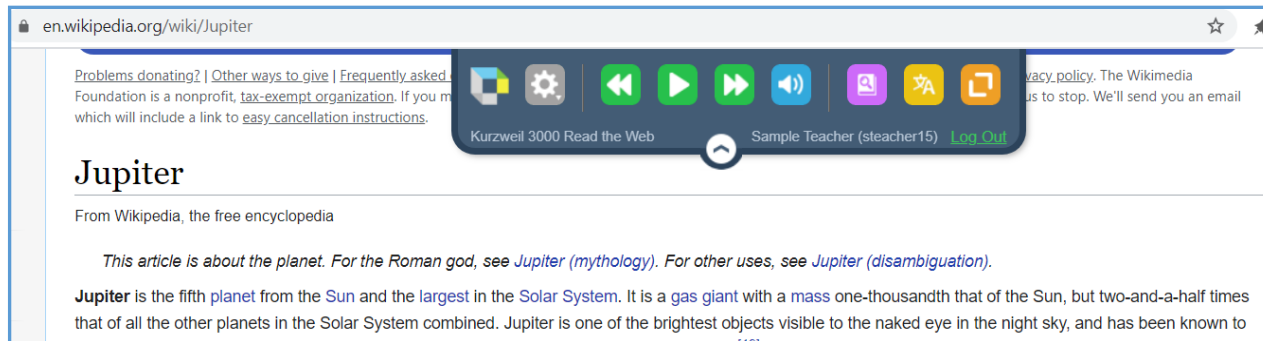
